

Stefano Sacchi is assistant professor of Political Science at the University of Milan, where he teaches Comparative Political Economy. He is also Carlo Alberto Affiliate of the Collegio “Carlo Alberto” of Turin, where he initiated the Master programme in Public Policy and Social Change (MAPS). In 2014 he held the “Luigi Einaudi” Chair at Cornell University. He has co-authored *The Political Economy of Work Security and Flexibility* (with F. Berton and M. Richiardi, 2012) and co-edited *The Politics of Structural Reforms* (with H. Magara, 2013). An expert of comparative social and labour market policy, he advised the Letta government on the introduction of a minimum income scheme and the Renzi government in the field of labour policy.
