In the latter case, a) the author must specify the status of the contribution submitted to the award (under examination or already published in a previous/extended version) b) **if awarded, the author will produce a resized/modified/translated version of the original article for the publication in the Quaderni del Premio “Giorgio Rota” series, following the Quaderni Giorgio Rota format.**

The Centro Einaudi’s policy is to acquire copyright in all contributions.

However, on the condition that **full acknowledgment of the Centro Einaudi and Fondazione CRT prize is given and a notification is sent to [applications-GR@centroeinaudi.it](mailto:applications-GR@centroeinaudi.it)**, all contributors retain the following non-transferable rights:

- the right to upload the final version of the awarded paper on their personal web page, after it has been published in the *Quaderni del Premio “Giorgio Rota”* ISBN working paper online serie;
- the right to reproduce revised or updated versions of the awarded paper in any volume of which they are editors, authors or co-authors;
- the right to publish revised or updated versions of the awarded paper either in a journal or in a volume edited by others;
- the right to make ‘not for commercial use’ hard copies of the final version of the awarded paper.
