

Maurizio Ferrera is Full Professor of Political Science at the Faculty of Political Science, Economics and Social Sciences (SPES) of the University of Milan. He serves as President of the Network for the Advancement of Social and Political Studies (NASP) among universities in Lombardy and Piedmont. He is a member of the Steering Committee of the Centro di Ricerca e Documentazione Luigi Einaudi (Turin), where he has founded and is the editor of the Comparative Politics and Public Philosophy Lab (LPP). Over the years he has worked in various commissions of inquiry and working groups for the Italian government, the European Union, the OECD and the ILO. His main fields of research are comparative politics and public policy analysis, with particular reference to the problems of the welfare state and European integration. On these topics he has published articles in leading international journals. Among his most recent books: *The Boundaries of Welfare* (2005); *Governance e politiche nell'Unione Europea* (edited with M. Giuliani, 2008); *Il fattore D.* (2008); *Alle radici del welfare all'italiana* (with M. Jessoula and V. Fargion, 2012); *Rotta di collisione. Euro contro welfare?* (2016). In 2013 he won an ERC Advanced Grant for a five year research project on "Reconciling Economic and Social Europe" (RESceEU). Since 2004 he has been a columnist for the *Corriere della Sera*. He is co-editor, with B. Magni, of *Biblioteca della libertà*.
