Federico Zuolo is currently Assistant Professor at the University of Genova. Before joining the University of Genova he held positions in Pavia, Trento, Hamburg and Berlin. His interests include public justification, animal ethics, toleration, respect, the treatment of diversity, and some issues in the history of philosophy. He published a monograph on Plato (Academia Verlag 2009), a new edition of Xenophon's Hiero (Carocci 2012) and an introduction to animal ethics (Etica e animali. Come è giusto trattarli e perché, il Mulino, 2018).
