1. REScEU: Executive Summary

Stand-alone description of the project and its outcomes

With the establishment of EMU and, in particular, during the euro-crisis, a visible strain has emerged between “Economic” and “Social” Europe. The EU’s social deficit has triggered an increasing politicization of redistributive issues within supranational, transnational and national arenas. The key challenge facing today political leaders is how to “glue” the Union together as a recognizable, functioning and legitimate polity. This requires a double rebalancing:

- 1) between the logic of supranational and transnational “opening” and the logic of national “closure”;
- 2) between the logic of “economic stability” and that of “social solidarity”.

How can we document empirically the clash between “Economic” and “Social” Europe? What are its causes? Is “reconciliation” possible, and how? These are the fundamental research questions that REScEU set out to address. The empirical analysis has focused on four clearly observable lines of conflicts, centered on the following issues:

- 1) the overall mission of the EU -market-making vs market-correcting;
- 2) the issue of cross-national transfers and solidarity;
- 3) the issue of free movement and access to domestic welfare;
- 4) the issue of competences, i.e. supranational integration vs domestic autonomy.

For each line of conflict, a host of empirical data have been collected: attitudinal data, social media data (twitter analysis), text-as- data (documents and speeches), qualitative data through elite interviews and process tracing.

Causal analysis has rested on the so-called “state-building” tradition in political science. Building on the neo-Weberian and neo-Rokkanian literatures, the project has elaborated an original theoretical framework. In the light of our framework, the “deconciliation” between Economic and Social Europe can be linked to two perverse and intertwined dynamics. The first dynamic is of a political and institutional nature: the crisis-induced revival of a *raison d'état* logic to the detriment of what might be termed *raison d'Union*; the increasing constriction of the European political sphere through an excess of

disciplinarian formalization (rigid rules and fixed targets), largely self-defeating in terms of polity maintenance. The second dynamic is of an intellectual nature: the emergence of an “econocratic paradigm” exclusively centered on instrumental objectives, which has dried up the *Spielraum* for alternative symbolic frames and has obstructed the elaboration of forward looking visions, more attentive to the “caring” side of the integration project. Both dynamics have been the object of intensive empirical and explanatory exploration, including through specific case studies.

The project has rested on the assumption that “reconciliation” is not only normatively desirable and functionally necessary. It is also a political prerequisite for rescuing the European project from the risk of backsliding or even dis-integration. Building on its theoretical framework and empirical analyses, REScEU has outlined a “free standing political justification” for reconciliation and, more specifically, the establishment of a fully-fledged European Social Union (ESU).

The findings of the mass surveys have shown a surprising and unexpected attitudinal potential for reconciliation. The Eurosceptic “fog” hides in fact vast pro-EU majorities of voters. While these silent majorities show notable fears about the social and political implications of integration, they also favor continuing EU membership, provided that the EU become more socially oriented. Voters seem ready to support a much higher degree of pan-European solidarity than currently available, including a favorable attitude *vis-à-vis* some of the policy solutions imagined by REScEU.

The elite surveys have shown however a much lower attitudinal potential for reconciliation among national politicians (MPs) and much greater divergences, especially as regards cross-national transfers and the establishment of more effective instruments and politics aimed at “socializing” the EU and “bonding” its peoples together.

In this light, deconciliation appears less as the result of an increasing “constraining dissensus” on the side of voters than as an elite failure in internalizing “communal values”, in understanding the functional flaws of the status quo (EMU in particular) and – last but not least – the disruptive effects of deconciliation on polity maintenance and legitimization. It must be noted, however, that during the 2014-2019 legislature, efforts have started to be made by the Commission and especially by the European Parliament to revive the social dimension of integration in both discursive and institutional terms.

Through two wide policy debates organized by REScEU's online observatory Euvisions, REScEU has involved a number of scholars from various disciplines as well as policy makers in elaborating and discussing policy proposals on how to enhance the social components of EU citizenship and how to possibly piece together the European Social Union from by exploiting the already existing *acquis* of social policies and "spaces". Thus, at the practical level, REScEU's bottom-line is that reconciliation is indeed possible, but only if carefully crafted through an extraordinary mobilization of political and intellectual resources.

2. Major Achievements

RESCEU has investigated the growing tensions between the economic and social dimensions of European integration, especially in the wake of the financial and economic crisis. The project set itself three broad scientific objectives:

- 1) theoretical knowledge: explaining de-conciliation in terms of ideational and political dynamics, pushing forward the frontiers of the state-building approach and of historical-institutional analysis;
- 2) empirical knowledge: documenting and analyzing the new conflict constellation emerged during the crisis around issues of worker mobility, cross-national transfers, the overall mission of the EU (euro-liberal vs euro-social) and the powers of “Brussels” vs national sovereignty;
- 3) policy evaluation and scenario building about the prospect of a European Social Union. Operationally, RESCEU developed along five different streams of activities.

The best way of summarizing the achievements of the project is to highlight the main outcomes of each stream.

Theory building: In line with the Description of Work (DOW), the project has elaborated a new framework of analysis by recombining insights from (neo)-Weberian and (neo)-Rokkanian theory. Such framework is centered on the interaction between the intellectual sphere (where policy ideas as well as broad normative visions are generated) and the political sphere (where decisions are taken and consensus is orchestrated by elected and state officials). Dynamics within these two spheres follow distinct logics and can take a variety of contents and forms, but must comply with a general and “foundational” constraint, i.e. keeping the underlying political community together. The empirical analyses of RESCEU have shown that such constraint has been violated in a number of moments and domains during the crisis. Recent developments suggest however that at least some top EU leaders have become aware of the disruption that can result from low or lacking polity maintenance capacities. The framework of analysis was initially outlined in a book by the Project Investigator (PI) [M. Ferrera, *"Rotta di collisione, Euro contro Welfare*, Laterza, Roma-Bari,

2016] and, in more detail and depth, in a series of articles appeared in top academic journals¹. The PI has signed a contract with Oxford University Press for a single-authored book manuscript on REScEU due to be delivered in the spring of 2020.

Theory probing and Theory application: Inspired by the general analytical framework (and of course feeding back into it), these two streams have collected and analyzed quantitative and qualitative data through a variety of methods: 4 different opinion surveys, documentary research, speech analyses, elite interviews, media analyses and twitter analyses, as well as through critical reviews of secondary sources. In general, REScEU's empirical investigations have not only confirmed, but also accurately documented the existence of the four lines of conflicts posited in the DOW. The 4 surveys have generated a real wealth of original and significant indications. At the most general level, they have signaled:

- the existence of much greater solidaristic dispositions among EU voters than normally supposed, even in the “core” or “creditor” member states;
- the less solidaristic stance of the elites (national MPS), with a juxtaposition between German and Swedish politicians on the one hand and Italian and Spanish on the other, with France and Poland somewhat in the middle²

This is an important finding, that induces a re-definition of the much talked about “constraining dissensus”, which now appears less as a demand-side than as supply-side phenomenon. The results of the REScEU surveys have been analyzed in various journal articles³, book chapters⁴ and working papers⁵, most of which have been already submitted to top journals. An edited volume is being planned building in particular on the results of the second mass survey. In addition to opinion analysis, a number of other topics have been investigated. As far as the ideates/intellectual sphere is concerned, the project has analyzed in particular the shifting notions of social solidarity and cohesion and the equally shifting policy

orientations regarding the following issues: free movement and access to welfare⁶, the strengthening of conditionality and fiscal discipline⁷, cross-national transfers and the role of ordoliberal doctrines⁸, the shifting ideational frame of cohesion policies since the 1970s⁹. As far as the political spheres concerned, the project has investigated both demand and supply side dynamics (see working papers section in www.resceu.eu). On the demand side, the project has analyzed electoral dynamics¹⁰ and social partnership dynamics¹¹. On the supply

side, the project has analyzed institutional dynamics¹² and the behavior of top EU leaders¹³. A number of empirical investigations have spanned across the two spheres and focused on key general developments of “de-conciliation”, such as regulatory competition and its social implications¹⁴ and the economic and social consequences of austerity in the European periphery¹⁵. Last but not least, the project has monitored more recent developments in a

“reconciliative” direction and analyzed in detail a number of EU policy innovations such as the Fund for European Aid to Deprived persons¹⁶, the “socialization of the European Semester¹⁷ and in particular the European Pillar of Social Rights¹⁸. A discernible and explicit *fil rouge* has run across all these topic-specific analyses and publications (their REScEU-inspired approach is often acknowledged in the text) and each written product was thoroughly discussed by the REScEU team in dedicated periodical meetings and thus conceived (by the PI and the various authors) as a ring of the analytical and explanatory chain of the overall project. As mentioned, each thematic stream of empirical research has fed back onto the overarching frame of analysis. All the “threads”, as it were, of the empirical part (and their contributions in probing and testing REScEU’s general theoretical propositions) will be pulled together by the PI in the OUP volume.

Policy evaluation, scenarios and proposals: The two major achievements on this front have been the “EU citizenship” and the “European Social Union” debates. Both debates rested on a common format: a broad introduction written by the PI presenting the topic, raising policy questions about it and outlining possible policy solutions and prospects; a number of invited contributions (often critical) by leading European scholars in the field and some top policy makers; a final response/conclusion by the PI. The EU citizenship debate was organized together with Rainer Baubock in the wake of the 2017 State of the Union event organized by the EUI in Florence. It addressed the question “should EU citizenship be

duty free?” The debate highlighted in particular the tension between “stayers” and “movers” and made interesting proposals to overcome such tension (including the issuing of a European Social Card to all EU citizens/residence and of some “nudging” forms of voluntary financial contributions on the side of national taxpayers (see chapters by M. Ferrera and I. Madama in R. Bauböck, (ed.) "Debating European Citizenship", Springer, 2019).

The ESU debate has appeared on EuVisions (www.euvvisions.eu) and has fleshed out the rationales and content of a possible, fully fledged European Social Union as a counterpart of EMU. This second debate has involved the “inventor” of the ESU idea (Frank Vandenbroucke) and has pushed forward the policy discussion on this idea (Ferrera, ESU debate, <http://www.euvvisions.eu/issues/europea-social-union-public-forum-debate/>). The ESU debate will be collected in a free standing REScEU publication available in open access on the REScEU website.

Dissemination: REScEU has lived up to the ambitious promises of the DOW, especially through the rich activity menu of EuVisions (www.euvvisions.eu). EuVisions was established immediately after the start of the project with as a sort of “operational arm”, so to speak, of REScEU’s academic research. Its mission was threefold:

- 1) developing an agile and user-friendly instrument for presenting the findings of four empirical investigations as well as of our conceptual and normative work;
- 2) serving as a forum for debates with colleagues and policy makers;
- 3) providing a testing ground for launching new ideas and practical proposals.

Resting on a visually creative and appealing website, EuVisions has hosted a very high numbers of contributions, grouped in different series and sections (Political briefings, Ideas monitor, Policy Focus, Dialogues, Infographics, Social media analysis). EuVisions has published a regular newsletter and has established various editorial partnerships (Eunews, Linkiesta, Opendemocracy, Quadrante futuro). In addition, the economic supplement of Il Corriere della Sera has invited EuVisions to supply a whole page of contents every other week, with text and data, and explicit acknowledgement to EuVisions. The list of events and conferences directly organized by REScEU/ EuVisions (including a final seminar at the European Parliament) or attended by the REScEU team testifies to the efforts that the project has made for implementing the demanding dissemination agenda outlined in the DOW. Building on the positive record registered during REScEU's lifetime, the PI is now trying to

find a new financial line to run the EuVisions Observatory over the next year, in order to maintain its highly valuable and appreciated dissemination function.

Novel and/or unconventional methodologies

The project has used a variety of quantitative and qualitative methods. It has pioneered on the front of twitter analysis, through a fruitful collaboration with the Center for Social Media Analysis (CASM), a leading research institution based in London. In addition, a novel methodology has been elaborated for speech analysis, based on the identification of discursive symbolic grapples¹⁹. The last (mass) public opinion survey has in turn elaborated a novel set of questions aimed at capturing in a novel and more detailed way “EU-politan” attitudes and their socio-economic correlates.

Inter and cross disciplinary developments

As specified in the DOW, the main disciplinary approach of REScEU has been political science, complemented by other approaches rooted in economics, law and political philosophy. This inter- and cross-disciplinary ambition has been reflected in staff recruitment, in the journals where the REScEU team has published (including, for example, the European Law Journal, Economic Papers, Constellations, the Journal of Common Market Studies) as well as in the seminars/conferences organized (see Annex). Both the EU citizenship and the ESU debate have involved scholars coming from several disciplines. The research streams on regulatory competition and on ordoliberalism have greatly benefited from the collaboration between lawyers, political scientists and political philosophers.

Knowledge and technology transfer

RESCEU has made outreaching efforts in two directions:

- liaising with other debate communities and research groups to encourage mutual learning and peer to peer knowledge transfers;
- signaling possible policy applications of its basic research findings to institutional and civil society actors.

The former effort has materialized through the organization of seminars and conferences and the attendance of the main yearly events of pertinent academic associations (ECPR, Council on European Studies, EUSA and others). The most significant results on this front have been two:

- 1) a joint collaboration with another ERC Adv project – POLCON – directed by Hanspeter Kriesi at the EUI; The collaboration has resulted in a novel joint proposal (including Waltraud Schelkle of the LSE) which has won a Synergy Grant in 2018 (SOLID - Syg - 810356). RESCEU and POLCON have served as springboards for developing a wider and much more ambitious research agenda on “Sovereignty, Solidarity and Identity in the EU” for the next 6 years;
- 2) a joint collaboration with Access Europe at University of Amsterdam. The collaboration with UVA has in its turn resulted in a new H2020 proposal which has won a grant in July 2019 (EUSOCIALCIT - H2020-SC6-GOVERNANCE-2019). RESCEU has transferred onto this new project the knowledge accumulated on EU social rights, the FEAD and the European Pillar of Social Rights. We are currently discussing the option of re-converting EuVisions as a dissemination tool for EUSOCIALCIT, the project is directed by Frank Vandenbroucke; Maurizio Ferrera is participating as the head of the Milan research unit.

The second broad effort made by RESCEU has been that of transferring knowledge from our project to the sphere of policy-making. Here we have first submitted a “proof of concept” proposal (HELMSPMAN - ERC POC - 825847) to the ERC on how to improve the delivery of EU social policies at the grass root level, to enhance their visibility and their returns in term of diffuse support for integration. This proposal built on the above mentioned EU social citizenship debate. Unfortunately the proposal was not selected. But we plan to re-

elaborate it and resubmit it. In addition to this, we have tried to make contact with EU policy-makers in order to transfer our ideas and proposals on the European Social Union. We were able to establish close links with the EP (as attested by the pod cast interviews to some MEPs on EuVisions) and we organized a high visibility event at the European Parliament itself in February 2019. We also established close links with the European-level social partners, especially with ETUC (as testified by a keynote speech by the PI at the ETUI) and OSE (European Social Observatory). The PI wrote the opening chapter of OSE's annual "state of play" report²⁰ and participated to a large-gathering conference organized by OSE in December 2018 (<https://www.etui.org/Events/Social-policy-in-the-European-Union-state-of-play-2018>). Despite our efforts, liaising with the Commission has proved more difficult. For example, despite our invitations, no officer accepted to contribute to the ESU debate or to speak at our events. This is a pity. The Commission should be the "natural" interlocutor of ERC projects and their PIs. As I had the occasion to argue in a forum on the future of the ERC held in Milan in December 2018 (4 December 2018, "Innovazione e ricerca, Verso Horizon Europe. ERC - Evoluzione o continuità?", Milano), the Commission has been very active in promoting frontier research, but somewhat passive in exploiting the results of those project that deal with pertinent subjects and might thus provide useful insights for EU policy making.

Enhancing the immediate research environment

RESCEU was able to create a research "hub" between Milan (Department of Social and Political Studies) and Turin (Centro Einaudi and the University of Torino, Department of cultures, politics and society). The collaboration with Turin will now at least in part continue through the PI's new European projects, SOLID and EUSOCIALCIT (see above). Largely thanks to RESCEU, closer cooperation has resulted between the Universities of Milan and Turin, which have signed an agreement for doctoral education in political and social studies (www.nasp.eu) as well as a memorandum of understanding on joint public opinion research initiatives. The acquisition of an ERC advanced grant has contributed to the selection of the

Milan Department of Social and Political Sciences as a “Department of excellence” by the Italian Ministry of Higher Education.

Establishment and/or consolidation of the research group and team composition

RESCEU has enhanced the local research environment also by recruiting Italian and foreign post- docs. Virtually all of them have now made progress in their careers, both in academia and in policy advise. In various parts and moments of its research, RESCEU has involved a number of doctoral students of Milan University in its activities. Four Ph.D. students have completed their thesis under the supervision of the PI on subjects related to RESCEU (see SESAM)

3.2- Most important conclusions

Theoretical conclusions:

During the last decade, the EU has entered in a deep polity crisis, affecting three foundational components of any territorial system of government: the boundary dimension (i.e. the contours of territorial, membership and functional spaces); the binding dimension (i.e. who is entitled to issue collective decisions on what and for whom); and the bonding dimension (who are we and what do we want to share among us). The deconciliation between Economic and Social Europe (i.e. the starting, overarching question of REScEU) is essentially linked to - and has been further exacerbated by - the polity crisis.

Polity crises may have exogenous origin, but they typically reflect the inadequacy of endogenous “polity maintenance” capacity. Polity maintenance is the condition of possibility for political production, which in turn is necessary for orderly social cooperation. Maintaining a polity is a very delicate task, which rests on both dedicated political activities (especially as regards legitimization), ideational commitments/”visions” and normative steering.

Polity maintenance capacities have always been a weak spot of the EU polity (i.e. the EU as an autonomous and distinctive political system). EU's legitimization through time has rested less on dedicated maintenance activities than on functional performance and "permissive consensus". The long post-2008 crisis has however suddenly eroded the EU functional legitimacy and witnessed the rise of a destructive spiral, which has challenged the three foundational dimensions of the EU polity (e.g. through sovereignism and boundary conflicts or through "voice for exit", as in Brexit).

EU authorities (and more generally, developments in the political and ideational spheres) have responded to functional problem pressures (especially during the euro-crisis) in ways that have gone in the opposite direction in respect of polity maintenance. Politically, they have reverted to intergovernmentalism, reducing EU policy making to a permanent bargaining among national executives, constrained by a disciplinarian regulative framework. Ideationally, they have re-shaped the EU's implicit normative order by marginalizing the social dimension, redefining the (timid) notions of supranational and cross-national solidarity which the EU had built since at least the 1970sin a restrictive and primarily "calculative" direction, exacerbating the asymmetry and imbalance between Economic and Social Europe.

RESCEU's arguments about polity maintenance contribute to the ongoing debate about the return of "grand theory" in EU studies, they are equally relevant for political and policy discussions about the future of the Euro-polity.

Empirical conclusions:

During the last decade a new conflict constellation has emerged within the Euro-polity, revolving around four main issues:

- 1) the traditional left-right conflict juxtaposing a euro-liberal and a euro-social integration project;
- 2) a conflict about supranationalism and national sovereignty;
- 3) a conflict around cross-national transfers, juxtaposing "core" vs "periphery" member states;

- 4) a conflict around free movement of persons and services, juxtaposing the supporters of opening vs the supporters of closure.

RESCEU has documented the presence, intensification, specific contents and forms of these four lines of conflict at the mass and elite levels (surveys) as well as in specific policy sectors and arenas (through case studies). This new conflict constellation has mainly resulted by elite choices, especially in the period 2009-2013. RESCEU argues that such choices (especially in the eurozone, in the field of macro-economic governance) opened the space for the rise of anti-EU formations in domestic political spaces and for the emergence of what EU studies call “constraining dissensus”. In the ideational sphere, a key driver of the new conflict lines has been the increased hegemony of ordoliberalism, especially among German elites.

A major finding of the RESCEU surveys is the seemingly high levels of support for a more social and solidaristic Europe among voters. These “silent majorities” offer a potential social coalition in support of a relaunch of integration “with a caring face”. Significant segments of such silent majorities consist of “EUPolitan” voters, i.e. genuine believers in the necessity and virtue of a more socially-oriented EU.

Our research has also documented a relative turn in the orientations and policy agenda of top EU leaders. This turn is both discursive (e.g. through public speeches or electoral platforms) and institutional. Since 2014, a number of innovative policy measures have indeed tried to strengthen the social dimension and making it more visible. Furthermore, the social dimension has acquired higher salience within European parties' manifestos in 2019 compared to 2014 elections. In this light the persisting pessimism still largely pervading academic and political debates about the EU and its future should be tempered by acknowledging that there are wide margins of maneuver for bypassing the extant (real or perceived) obstacles for taking further steps in EU building.

Practical conclusions:

In order to move in this direction, a broad strategy should be developed in order to reconnect the pro-integration supply with the pro-integration demand. This strategy should rest on both symbolic and tangible policy initiatives.

In the wake of the EU social citizenship debate, REScEU has proposed a substantial strengthening of the social component of EU citizenship. Here is a summary of our proposals:

- 1) Compensating/enabling the “stayers” (i.e. the majority of citizens who do not take advantage of mobility rights): a EU Fund to ease the impact of mobility; a system of (transferable) universal vouchers for mobility/upskilling purposes;
- 2) Autonomizing the movers through an EU social insurance scheme for mobile workers;
- 3) Universal empowerment of all citizens: a social card for access to a whole range of EU funded facilitating services;
- 4) Enhancing the visibility of the Global Adjustment Fund, the Fund for European Aid the Deprived Persons and the various initiatives of the European Social Fund; A EU insurance against the victims of terrorism and persons injured in the line of duty; Enhancing the external protections linked to the EU passport.

In the wake of the ESU debate, REScEU has proposed the establishment of a fully-fledged European Social Union. This would not need to start from scratch, but could be pieced together by reassembling in a systematic and coordinate way the following ingredients: national social spaces; cross-border social spaces: the EU mobility space; EU social policies in the strict sense; the fundamental social principles contained in the Lisbon Treaty and recently systematized by the European Pillar of Social Rights. The European Social Union should become the “counterpart” of EMU. These two Unions should be linked together by a smart inventive system so that they can work in synergy.

In his last book in Italian (M. Ferrera, La società del Quinto Stato, Laterza, Roma-Bari, 2019) the PI addresses also the thorny question of how to build a supporting coalition in favor of reconciliation (and more generally a more incisive policy transformation, aligning social protection/investment to the new risk configuration) at both the domestic and the EU level.

3.3- Advancements in respect to the state of the art

- Empirical illustration of the four lines of conflict and their cross-cutting relevance;
- The presence of “more solidarity than meets the eye” among voters as well as the presence of significant pro-EU (social EU) silent majorities;
- The lack of solidarism among the elites and thus the constraining dissensus as an elite failure;
- Influence of German ordoliberalism;
- The impact of the crisis on Southern Europe (see in SESAM Matsaganis’ “To the brink and back in Greece” and Gago’s “Crisis, cambio en la UE y estrategias sindicales: el impacto de la condicionalidad en el repertorio estratégico de los sindicatos españoles durante la crisis de la eurozona”);
- “De-conciliation” in social media;
- The “social turn” in EU legitimating communication.

Citizenship debate

In the forum debate, edited by Maurizio Ferrera and Rainer Bauboeck, Maurizio Ferrera argues for strengthening EU citizenship in order to make it not only attractive for mobile Europeans but also for ‘stayers’ who feel left behind in processes of globalisation and European integration. According to Ferrera, EU citizenship is primarily ‘isopolitical’ and regulatory; it confers horizontal rights to people to enter the citizenship spaces of other member states and it imposes duties of non-discrimination on these states without providing for redistribution in response to perceived or real burdens resulting from free movement. Ferrera suggests several reforms that aim broadly at empowering the stayers. Among his proposals are an “EU social card”, universal transferrable vouchers for accessing social rights in other member states that stayers can pass on to their children who want to move, and a European wide social insurance scheme that would supplement those of the member states. He also suggests to strengthen EU citizenship with some soft duties, such as earmarking a small percentage of personal income tax for EU social policies or raising funds for such policies through fees on an EU social card or EU passports. Some respondents to Ferrera’s essay deny that free movement creates burdens that call for compensation or insist that EU citizenship should remain duty free. Others focus on the sources of solidarity and ask what duties of social justice apply to the EU. Several authors support Ferrera’s arguments while advocating bolder policy reforms. “European Social Union: a public forum debate” is an editorial project dealing with the possible establishment of a European Social Union (ESU), the prospects of the European Pillar of Social Rights (EPSR) and the role that the latter might play as one of ESU’s key components. A set of articles authored by high-level academic figures has discussed the raison d’être of ESU, the EPSR and their mutual link from a variety of perspectives. EuVisions is the most significant tool in terms of output which could be useful for the scientific community. Combining academic rigour, the use of infographics and an eye on current events makes EuVisions a unique experiment, which aims not only to speak to different audiences and to bridge the gap between scholars and laypeople interested in this subject. EuVisions has taken advantage of two types of innovative tools to disseminate the project's research: 1) Infographics – short data visualizations mainly based on social media or survey data; 2) Podcasts - interviews made by the EuVisions team during which policy experts, politicians and institutional representatives discuss the prospects of the establishment of a European Social Union.

The REScEU core research is entirely available on the website www.resceu.eu. The REScEU researchers have produced a Working Papers series (WP) registered with ISSN 2531-9159 available in open access on the website. On the basis of such WPs, the researchers have produced journal articles published by prestigious Peer Reviewed Journals, which only allow Open Access under extremely expensive arrangements, which did not fit the REScEU budget. Nevertheless, we adopted two strategies to comply as much as possible with the recommendation to publish in open access. Whenever possible, we have published research in open access for prestigious journals and publishers. See, for example, in SESAM the Tortola-Pansardi paper in open access on European Journal of Political Research, the articles published on the "European Papers" journal, the Citizenship debate edited for Springer, the debate "Should EU citizenship be duty free?", available on the Cadmus EUI website, Josef Hien's publication on Ordoliberalism, available in open access in the European University Institute website.

Secondly, UNIMI has subscribed to the Italian AIR regulation (archivio nazionale della ricerca), which implements the policies of Recommendation 2012/417/UE on dissemination and repository of scientific publications. A commission has been appointed by UNIMI, which checks all publications uploaded on AIR. The University does its best to ensure access to all the Contributions deposited in the Archive, based on the legislation on Copyright and the contracts stipulated with the publishers. Whenever the editorial digital version can't be

made public, the Author, if she/he deems it appropriate, may upload the "peer-reviewed digital version" of the publication, accompanied by a declaration (metadata) of congruence with the published version. The REScEU researchers have committed to upload their research on AIR, in compliance with the Copyright regulations.
