Heather Alexander is the Coordinator of Canada's International Development Research Centre's (IDRC) Research Chairs Network on Forced Displacement and an expert on refugee law, forced displacement, and statelessness. Her academic work focuses on statelessness among nomadic and mobile peoples, legal identity, refugee law, and climate change. She has a PhD in law from Tilburg University in the Netherlands. She was an Associate Protection Officer for UNHCR in Chad and Sri Lanka. She has served as a consultant for UNHCR, the US State Department, the University of Melbourne and the GlobalCit project at the Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies. She is also a former US Peace Corps volunteer in Gabon and a co-founder of United Stateless, an advocacy group for stateless people in the USA.
