

**Claudia Morgana Cascione** is Associate Professor of Comparative Private Law at the Department of Law of the University of Bari Aldo Moro. She obtained the national scientific qualification as a full professor in the sector 12/E2. She teaches Comparative Private Law and Comparative Contract Law in the Master's Degree courses of the Department of Law, and she is also involved in doctoral and master's courses. She is the Director's delegate for activities related to the Third Mission, as well as a member of the AQ Commission and the Interclass Council of the Department of Law of the University of Bari Aldo Moro. She is a member of the editorial boards of numerous Italian and foreign scientific journals.

She participates in numerous research projects; among the most recent, she is PI of the Prin 2022 project, Demographic and legal changes. Towards an elder law; member of the PNRR AGE-It project. A novel public-private alliance to generate socioeconomic, biomedical and technological solutions for an inclusive Italian ageing society. She has spent several periods of research abroad, in Germany, the United Kingdom and the United States. She is the author of two monographs and around 70 publications (chapters in collective works, articles in scientific journals, notes on court rulings) focusing on several main themes: The relationship between public and private property and the impact of privatisation on the traditional category of public goods; Fundamental rights and, in particular, privacy and personal data protection; The rights of vulnerable persons, with particular attention to the rights of the elderly.
