Mario De Caro is Professor of Moral philosophy at Roma Tre University and regularly a Visiting professor at Tufts. He was Fulbright fellow at Harvard, Visiting Scholar at MIT, and President of the Italian Society for Analytic Philosophy; presently he is vice-president of the Consulta Nazionale di Filosofia. He is Hilary Putnam's literary executor and the author of *Azione* (il Mulino, 2008), *Il libero arbitrio* (Laterza, 2020<sup>9</sup>), *Realtà* (Bollati Boringhieri, 2020). With Maria Silvia Vaccarezza he edited *Practical Wisdom* (Routledge 2020); with David Macarthur he edited *Naturalism in Question* (Harvard University Press, 2004) and *Naturalism and Normativity* (Columbia University Press, 2010), and is working on the monograph *Liberal Naturalism* (Harvard University Press).
