**Francesco Ferraro** is Associate Professor of Philosophy of Law at the University of Milan. He is the author of three books and of book chapters and articles on Jeremy Bentham's thought and utilitarianism, on legal and moral rights, on legislative rationality and 'legisprudence', on nudging, and on the symbolic functions of law. Together with Silvia Zorzetto, he has recently co-edited the volume *Exploring the Province of Legislation: Theoretical and Practical Perspectives in Legisprudence* (Springer, 2022).
