Roberta Sala is Full Professor of Political Philosophy at Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, where she teaches courses in political philosophy, public ethics, political legitimacy and democratic theory. She is Director of CeSEP (Centre for Studies in Ethics and Politics) and President of the Undergraduate Programme of the Faculty of Philosophy. Her research interests focus on normative political theory, public ethics and bioethics. She is the author of several books and articles, including Il silenzio di Dio: religione, credenze, rispetto (Edizioni Sanpaolo, 2014) and Filosofia per i professionisti della cura (Carocci, 2014).
