

Alessandro Ferrara is Professor of Political Philosophy at the University of Rome Tor Vergata and former President of the Italian Association for Political Philosophy. Recently he has published *Rousseau and Critical Theory* (Brill, 2017) and *The Democratic Horizon. Hyperpluralism and the Renewal of Political Liberalism* (Cambridge UP, 2014). He has also authored *The Force of the Example. Explorations in the Paradigm of Judgment* (Columbia UP, 2008); *Justice and Judgment* (Sage, 1999), and *Reflective Authenticity* (Routledge, 1998). An editorial advisor to *Constellations, Philosophy and Social Criticism* and *The European Journal of Philosophy*, co-editor of the series *Philosophy & Politics* (Springer), he serves as co-director of the yearly Conference *Philosophy and Social Science*, yearly held in Prague under the aegis of the Czech Academy of Science.
